SAMPLE ANSWER

My dream city

If I could make my own dream city, I would like it to have old-style houses that people kept them the way they were and they have not built in their place ugly block of flats. My dream city will also have beautifull parks with lots of trees and flowers and places for children to play and feel safe, away from cars and motorbikes. Finally, my dream city will have no traffic and everyone will go to work very quickly. I hope my dream city will be true one day!

<u>Comments</u>: This is a fully satisfactory script, as the communicative purpose has been achieved (i.e., to describe one's ideal city), the genre is appropriate (i.e., text to enter a magazine's writing contest), the tone is personal and direct and the script has been written in an informal style, as expected. In terms of text grammar, the script is well-organised and coherent. In terms of sentence grammar, the lexicogrammatical choices are conducive to the communicative purpose of the text, with a spelling error (e.g., "beautifull") and cases of awkward phrasing (e.g., "old-style houses that people kept them the way they were") which however do not impede intelligibility.
